He has authored a variety of code-related support publications, including the IBC Illustrated Handbook and the Significant Changes to the International Building Code.

Explain the fundamental provisions of the 2015 IBC. Identify the intent of the building code. Describe the common provisions applicable to design of commercial buildings. Comprehend the use of passive and active fire protection. Identify how life safety and egress issues are addressed in design and construction. Identify how the health and safety of occupants is safeguarded with weather protection and interior environment controls. These concepts provide a basis for the correct utilization of the code. This will allow the code user to apply the IBC in specific situations and helps to build an understanding of the intent of the code when asked to make a judgement on code compliance. This course will also help the code user to correctly locate code requirements.
