- Inspections of exterior of properties for compliance with City public nuisance codes and Roseville's Building Maintenance and Preservation Code.
- Inspections on residential construction work in new or existing structures to ensure work is performed consistent with applicable codes and ordinances.
- Provide customer service to the public at the front counter by issuing building permits, scheduling inspections, and answering questions.

Minimum qualifications:

- Coursework beyond high school in building codes, construction management, carpentry, plumbing, HVAC, architecture, project management, or other closely related field.
- Good oral and written communication skills.
- Customer service experience.
- Valid Minnesota Driver's License.
- Experience in construction trades desired.
- Must be able to regularly perform the physical actions necessary to conduct inspections at, above, or below ground level of construction sites, which may include walking long distances. The employee may occasionally move between 25-60 pounds and 30-50% of the work is performed outside.
