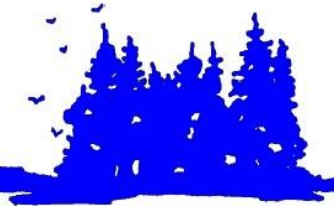

- 4. Approval of Business Meeting Minutes of March 3rd, 2016:** Motion to approve was made by Terry Zajac, 2nd Tom Bakken – passed
- 5. Guest Presentation:** USG Building Systems representative Chris Anderson gave a ½ hour presentation on some gypsum products that are new to the industry. He brought examples of mildew resistant, lighter, and thinner gypsum board products, and what their impact is on codes regarding moisture resistance and fire ratings. He answered questions from the attendees.
- 6. State Code Division Report:** Don Sivigny addressed the assembly.
 - The need for better representation of Minnesota code officials at the code hearings was discussed. The next code hearings will be held in Kansas City October 19-25.
 - The state is announcing the 2nd Annual Building Official’s Forum with “round table discussion” at Camp Ripley on June 17th. Registration is available on line, and there is no fee for attendance.
 - The state is offering a 2 hour seminar on the Existing Building Code. Check the DOLI web site for times and locations.

- The Minnesota State Fire Code was officially adopted in April. The amended fire code is currently at the publisher, and should be available by the end of May.
- Radon legislation is moving through the House & Senate.
- “Tiny House” information is available on the CCLD web site.

8. 10,000 Lakes Committee Reports:
